It is acceptable and not considered redundant to discuss your academic achievements in the required essays).** Applicants will be notified of the final decision of the Scholarship Awards Committee as soon as one is made. These winners will be requested to meet with the Scholarship Awards Committee for a personal interview at a date, time and place to be announced. It is imperative that you make yourself available for this interview if you are chosen as one of the finalists. This interview will determine the first, second, third, fourth and fifth place award winners.

Any transfer or new hire that becomes a member of EBMA within 60 days of transfer or employment at Electric Boat will be exempted from the 36-month period, with a reduced 24-month membership period applicable instead.
